

Southern Districts: Monday, Thursday Burnable Garbage Northern Districts: Tuesday, Friday Plastic Garbage **Every Wednesday** September, March **Batteries** Harmful Garbage Fluorescent June, December **Tubes** Non-Burnable Once every month Garbage



Please separate your garbage, and sure to protect the separation time for each resident's association-designated garbage area (8:30 AM)!!

Please put out by 8:30 AM on the designated day, in the designated bag. Note: Items that cannot fit in the designated bag will to go "bulk garbage."

# Burnable Garbage Tempura Oil Permeated Cloth or Seafood Shells Raw Garbage Drain any water and Solidified by Coagulant put in the garbage bag Cold Pack Stuffed Animals Disposable Commercial Pet Sand Leather/Rubber Diapers **Products** (Remove Waste) Garden Tree Pruning Garbage – Leaves, Woodchips, Grass, etc. Within 5 cm diameter, up to 50 cm length Note: Remove soil and let dry Plastic Products Ex:Plastic toys, cutting boards, buckets, wash basins, hangars, CDs, DVDs, planters



Empty the contents and rinse with water

\*1 – Items with non-removable dirt go to "burnable waste"

Please remove any non-plastic materials, such as paper labels, to the best of your ability

\*2 - Please remove caps and lids.

\*3 – Please do not double-bag.




